BOARD OF MANAGERS MEETING MINUTES CANYON REGIONAL WATER AUTHORITY

- 1 Open Meeting & Corrections to May 8, 2024, Meeting Notes (Justin Ivicic)
 - » Justin Ivicic opened the meeting at 10:01 AM.
- 2 New Appointments to the Board of Managers
 - » Mike Saldana, Assistant General Manager of Crystal Clear SUD, will be joining the Board of Managers.

3 Water Precipitation/Drought Update: (Kerry Averyt)

- » Adam Telfer gave an update on the precipitation and drought conditions. As of August 27th, we are still in extreme drought conditions. Stage 3 drought restrictions are still in effect. Canyon lake is 56% full. More water is being taken out of Canyon Lake than what is going in.

4 General Construction / Design Projects:

- Brandon Rohan gave an update regarding the current construction projects. The two TxDOT Transmission Line projects are behind schedule. The scheduled completion date for these projects now is in October. The challenges with the contractors are being documented for future reference. The Zuehl Road project will begin the bore pit next week. Garver gave a presentation to the Construction Committee that will also be given to the Board of Trustees containing updates on the prefilters at the Lake Dunlap WTP. The Hays Caldwell Phase 2 Improvements will possibly contain the building, ozone, and filters. This is still being put together by Ardurra and CRWA Staff. The entire project cannot be funded with the money that CRWA currently has, so there will be a Phase 3 of this project. The THM issues that the systems are facing were discussed. The ozone will be the long-term solution to this issue. The THM issue will be addressed in Phase 2 of the Hays Caldwell WTP for the membrane replacement project. Hays Caldwell WTP is currently a Koch System, and that system is no longer in use so the whole system will need to be replaced. The Pilot Study will be to see which one will be best for Hays Caldwell WTP.
- » There was discussion on what funding CRWA has applied for regarding the Hays Caldwell Improvement Project. David McMullen, CRWA Operations Manager, confirmed that CRWA submitted a Revolving Fund preapplication to the Texas Water Development Board, and is currently waiting for an invite to submit a full application.
- » There is a route identified for the Hays Caldwell Pipeline. Texas Land and right of Way will work on getting the 8 easements needed for the pipeline.

» The Lake Dunlap WTP and the Hays Caldwell WTP are under usage compared to last year. The Wells Ranch WTP has been utilized more than last year.

- » <u>Lake Dunlap WTP</u>: Nanostone continues to be an issue that is addressed in executive session with the Board of Trustees. There is no update on the ARWA Interconnect.
- » <u>Wells Ranch WTP</u>: There was an outage at a facility that has a generator on sight, that does not operate correctly. GVEC had an outage that affected the station, but it was fixed. Ardurra is working on the Generator Project and is waiting on information from STV.
- » <u>Hays Caldwell WTP</u>: Tank construction is slated to be completed in June 2025. Phase 1 Improvements will include the tank construction, electrical, plumbing, and the fence.
